

SAILING PRACTICE – part 3 (41)

Sailing Practice - part 3 is to take place only after successful completion of Sailing Practice – part 2 and after the second or third year of study. The main objective of this practice is to teach how to perform the main duties and activities of the deck cadet and the naval officer. During this Practice students participate in the work of the Deck Department and the navigational team on the bridge, carrying out specific tasks under the guidance of the ship's Master or the officers designated by him. At the end of this Practice students must know and be able to perform the duties of the deck cadet, which is the first step in the professional development of navigational officers and the first position to be taken by them upon graduation.

Primary topics in the training:

- Tank measurement
- Technical Maintenance of the Ship
- Maintenance of Lifesaving and Firefighting Equipment
- Deck Operations
- Mooring Operations
- Pilot Embarkation and Disembarkation Operations
- Port Operation and Cargohandling Operations.
- Watchkeeping and Security Activities.
- Logkeeping during a Sea Voyage.
- Navigation
