TU - Varna forwards the documents of the approved applicants to the Ministry of Education and Science, according to Art. 95, para. 8 of Higher Education Act in order to be issued a Visa for Long-Stay (type D).

After receiving the Certificate from the Ministry of Education and Science, the applicants must submit their documents to the Embassy / Consulate of the Republic of Bulgaria in order to receive a Long-Stay Visa (type D).

After obtaining the Visa, the applicants can be enrolled at the University.

Deadline for the submission of documents: by 15th of September

The applicants who have successfully passed the language exam at TU-Varna can apply by **15th of January** All students who have successfully completed their studies at TU-Varna, with a diploma for Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree, receive a European Diploma Supplement.

ADMISSION CRITERIA:

In order to apply for education in TU-Varna, the minimum examination grades from specific subjects, taught at school SHOULD NOT be less than 62% out of the maximum value of the assessment system in the respective country.

All the applicants who do not have knowledge of the language in which the course will be performed have to complete a preparatory course. It includes two modules: Language training (650 class periods) and Specialized training (350 class periods).

In case the applicant is fluent in the language in which the training will be performed, he/she may take the language examinations (the examination in the language in which the training will be performed) without having passed the training. The exam is spoken and written and it shall sit for an examination before to a committee.

Persons who have successfully completed the preparatory course are issued a Certificate of Language and Specialized Training, which shall allow them to continue their studies at Bachelor's Degree.

^{*}Documents specified in points 2, 3 and 4 must be certified in accordance with the international requirements and translated in Bulgarian language with legalized translation in Bulgaria. It is necessary to send the translated documents for certification of the translator's signature to the Bulgarian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
