Annotation: The subject aims to develop students' practical skills in making up witness statements on various accidents at sea by developing their written culture in a specialized context. For this purpose, revision of the past tenses in the English language in a maritime context is included, the reasons and circumstances for writing a witness statement are explained, the structure of a witness statement is presented, a revision of terms is made and knowledge of terms is enhanced in the process of writing, related to accidents on board and at sea. The syllabus complies with the recommendations of the IMO Model Course 3.17 Maritime English.

Basic sections of the contents:

- Revision of past tenses in a maritime context;
- Explaining the reasons and circumstances for writing a Witness Statement. Presenting the structure of a Witness Statement;
- Making up witness statements on behalf of a ship's mate on the basis of marine accidents. Revision and enhancing the knowledge of terminology related to accidents at sea and on board in the process of writing.
