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Annotation:

The course of Specialised English – Part 4aims to expand the knowledge of the students in specialised maritime English language and improve theirlanguage skills. The lexical and syntactic units and constructions introduced in the previous semesters are revised, consolidated and diversified. The specialised vocabulary is enriched, the selection and the sequence of the topics in the curriculum being in accordance with the curriculum of the specialty. The emphasis is on improving students’ reading skills, translation of specialised authentic texts and developing writing skills through descriptions of schemes in line with the topics set out in the programme. The course ensures developing listening and speaking skills through discussions and oral presentations on thematically-related topics and thus focuses on all four communicative skills required for the effective interaction in the particular professional field.
