Learning objectives: The basic objectives of the course is to provide knowledge in the field of protection of the intellectual property rights. /ANNOTATION/ The course aims to provide students with specialized knowledge on the protection of intellectual property. Basic concepts of intellectual property, types of sources of regulation, objects of protection, principles and methods of protection are considered. Students are introduced to industrial property objects (inventions, utility models, brands, geographical indications, industrial design, integrated circuit topologies), as well as other contemporary and current intellectual property objects such as databases and computer programs. The course covers the study of domestic law enforcement sources. Emphasis is placed on the introduction of international sources into our national law, a comparison is made with European sources and the consequences of their inaccurate transposition.
