*The document should be issued no earlier than one month prior to submitting the application documents to TU-Varna.

6. Copy of passport/ID card;

*Documents specified in points 2, 3 and 4 must be certified, legalized and translated in accordance with the International Agreements between Republic of Bulgaria and the country in which they are issued; in case of lack of these documents – by the common order of the legalizations, translations and validations of the documents and the other papers.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:

The applicants must obtain Academic Grade Average from Secondary School Diploma (Academic Grade Average from the Grade Average of the course subjects included into the Course Content and Grade Average of the State Examinations or of the Diploma Thesis) **not less than the Grade "Good".**
