

### **English – part 3 (21)**

Annotation: The aim of the course is to acquaint the students of Navigation with the basic maritime terminology so that they could build practical skills for reading comprehension and translation of original texts in Maritime English related to accidents at sea. Excerpts from the International Convention for Preventing Collisions at Sea are also studied which aims at acquiring the necessary terminology. Grammar exercises are provided to review the language skills developed during the first two semesters. The syllabus elaboration takes into account the recommendations of the IMO Model Course 3.17 Maritime English.

Basic sections of the contents:

- Reporting accidents at sea and on board due to noncompliance with the safety regulations and requirements;
- Terminology associated with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea;
- Revision of grammar.
