Annotation: The course aims at discussing typical actions during accidents as well as emergency onboard procedures, enriching the terminological knowledge of students, developing reading comprehension skills and translation of selected specialized texts on the subject. Emphasis is placed on familiarizing students with the IMO Standard Marine Communication Phrases in relation to safety on board. The structure and purpose of the IMO conventions and codes as well as the purposes and procedures of the Port State Control are discussed. Students are trained to read and write letters, emails and faxes related to cargo-handling operations, developing practical skills for ship's correspondence. The IMO Standard Marine Communication Phrases on passenger care on board passenger ships are reviewed. The syllabus complies with the recommendations of IMO Model Course 3.17 Maritime English.

- Brief Introduction to IMO Conventions and Codes. Port State Control;
- Revision of Tenses for Making up Ship's Correspondence;
- Explaining the Structure of Writing Letters, E-Mails, Faxes;

- IMO SMCP for passenger care.
